

PELORUS COMMUNITY PRESCHOOL Enrolments/Admissions Policy

Education [Early Childhood Services] Regulations 2008 (and it's Amendments): Regulation 47

Licensing Criteria for Early Childhood Education and Care Centres 2008: Criterion GMA10

Rationale

The Pelorus Community Preschool shall be accessible to parents and caregivers requiring care and education for their preschool children

Objectives:

ENROLMENT

- All children regardless of their race, creed, special needs or health, shall have the right of enrolment and admission
- Enrolments are to be made on the Pelorus Community Preschool Enrolment Form
- Parents are responsible for the accuracy of the enrolment information. Any changes in this information need to be in writing and signed by the custodial parent, whanau or caregiver.
- Enrolments should be made, in writing, by the custodial parent, whanau or caregiver
- Enrolments (including casuals) will be limited strictly to preschool aged children (under 6 years old) not already enrolled at school.
- Wellchild Immunisation Certificates must accompany the enrolment
 - The maintenance of a waiting list and the maintenance of the preschool roll are the responsibility of the Senior Teacher

- Regardless of age, enrolments must be made for a minimum of two full sessions (covering 2 separate days). Pelorus Community Preschool believe one week between visits is not conducive to the happy integration of the child into the preschool environment.
- <u>As a community owned and operated preschool, parents will be required to agree that they are willing to participate in parent help at the preschool.</u>

ADMISSION

Admission to any session is at the discretion of the Senior Teacher.

The teachers will consider all factors when admitting a child and determining the order of such admission-this includes

- Learning needs
- Medical Reasons
- Behavioural Issues

Licensing Criteria

Enrolment records are maintained for each child attending. Records are kept for at least 7 years (GMA10).
